Market Update:

Tariffs, tariffs, tariffs continues to be the hot topic which is really impacting both propane and fuel markets.

Propane is starting to see some builds of inventory on the national level, although we are still below the 5 year average. With the continued exporting volume, it could mean that propane struggles to see much lower volumes. If you were to pin me down and ask my opinion, I would be 60% that we will see a pull off of propane values. Having said that, I am not too optimistic that we will see a drastic reduction in the propane value with the national inventory being so low. If the inventory levels remain low throughout the summer, that could mean with any kind of normal winter higher pricing. This appears to be a year where you will want to have a propane contract in place.

For diesel fuel, as I am writing this on Thursday May 29th crude is hovering around the 60 point mark. The first week in June, we will be sending out contracts to those that contract fuel for last fall. I do believe that there is a good value here to take advantage of the lower priced crude.
